# **Leadership Committee for English Education in Québec (LCEEQ)**

## **Strategic Plan 2013-2016**

Updated – August 2013

## **Mandate**

**The Leadership Committee for English Education in Québec – LCEEQ** is a collaborative professional learning community established for the purpose of promoting educational leadership in response to the needs of the English educational community of Québec through:

- identification of systemic challenges and conditions for student success;
- short and long-term strategic planning to enhance and support:
  - student learning and effective pedagogical and andragogical practices;
  - professional development and delivery models appropriate to the English sector;
  - the timely availability of resources for the English sector;
- exchange on information between the ministère de l'Éducation, du Loisir, et du Sport (MELS), le ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur, de la Recherche, de la Science et de la Technologie (MESRST) and the community as represented by the LCEEQ;
- systematic review and revision of the purpose, processes and outcomes of the LCEEQ.

### **Preamble**

The number associated with each Strategic Goal is to facilitate discussion, not to establish priority. A timeline document will be published at each meeting of the LCEEQ to monitor the progress made for each of the actions proposed.

## **Strategic Goal One**

To be a visionary and strategic body that advises and influences decisions regarding English education in Québec.

### **What we will do**

LCEEQ will focus on the needs of the English sector as a whole; and it will identify and develop means to improve student success.

### **How we will do it**

LCEEQ will:

- engage in active reflection on current and future issues;
- implement a communication plan to keep the English education community informed;
- develop and/or support strategies which address the educational needs of the English community;
- collaborate with Secteur des Services aux anglophones, aux autochtones, et aux communautés culturelles (SSAACC);
- support effective processes for student success in the youth, adult, technical/vocational, CEGEP, and university sectors.

## **Strategic Goal Two**

To be effectively involved with the MELS and MESRST throughout the development of policies, program elaboration, resource development, implementation, and evaluation, so as to ensure quality education for all learners in the English sector, while advocating for timely delivery of the same.

### **What we will do**

LCEEQ will develop and articulate positions to MELS and MESRST on educational issues relevant to the English educational community.

### **How we will do it**

LCEEQ will:

- proactively reflect on the challenges facing the English educational community;
- support the delivery of educational services including any adaptations, as required, to meet the specific needs of the English educational community;
- become aware at an initial phase of MELS/MESRST's intentions, trends, initiatives, and projects;
- communicate to the MELS/MESRST unified and strategic positions on educational issues.

- review and implement the Professional Development Plan in collaboration with our educational partners through the Professional Development Subcommittee;
- collaborate with SSAACC on delivery of *formations ministérielles*;
- maintain centralized professional development funding procedures;
- measure outcomes of professional development undertaken by LCEEQ.

- ensure that the agenda reflects the inclusion of substantial, relevant items identified by members;
- reflect on the previous year, modify the Strategic Plan as necessary, and continue to evaluate short and long term goals to address the needs of the English educational community;
- engage all members as active participants contributing to the vision and goals of the committee.
